



Adult Disability Day Services and COVID-19 What's Happening in July 2021?



75% Transport Capacity



- Public Transport is now operating to **75% capacity** and we are advising that transport in disability day services should now also be operating to at least this capacity.

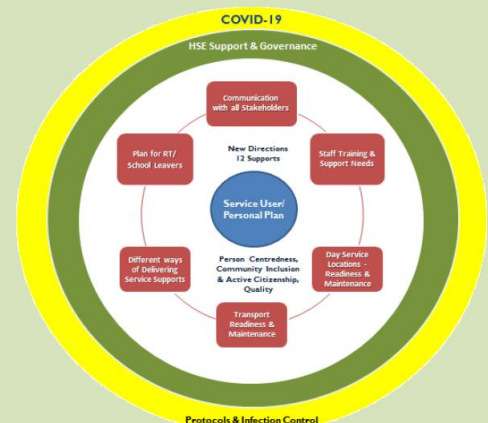
90% Fully Vaccinated by end of July

- 90% of Service Users and Staff** will be vaccinated by end of July, We are revising our guidance for day services to reflect the protection provided by this high vaccination level. This revised guidance will be issued in August and should enable further capacity in day service locations.



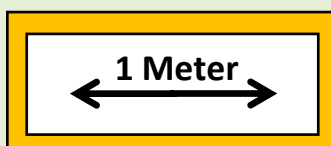
Guidance will be updated in August

- Guidance will be updated** that will show the benefits of vaccination protection and also acknowledge the reopening of community based services.



Key Reminders

- All service users that live at home with their families should be receiving at least **60%** (pre-COVID) day service at their day location.
- Those in receipt of residential and day services should now be receiving part of their day supports back in their day location. This should increase gradually to full location based service.



- The social distance operating in day services is 1 meter (unless an individual risk assessment indicates otherwise).
